The Word This Week

"This is my commandment, that you love one another."

Today's Gospel recounts a moment during the Last Supper, the final evening Jesus spent with his disciples. Earlier during the meal, Jesus had told them that he would be betrayed, he would be denied and he would die. What a somber and sad Passover for his shocked and confused followers.

Jesus has no secrets with is disciples. opens his heart to them, revealing to them the knowledge the Father has given him and his love for each of them. He demonstrates his profound love and that of his Father by laying down his life for us, suffering and dying on the cross for our salvation. His love has no limits, embracing everyone and giving everything.
