

Catholics must confess their sins at least once a year, as

per the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) as this "...ensures preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the sacrament of reconciliation, which continues Baptism's work of conversion and forgiveness." (CCC 2042)

On Tuesday, December 19th, a priest will be available to hear your confession from 9am-11:30am, 1pm-3pm, and 7pm-9pm. This sacrament is also available every Saturday before Mass. Visit www.archtoronto.org/confession to find confession times at various churches across Toronto.

DISPOSING OF SUNDAY MISSALS:





The Word of God is to be disposed of properly since it is through God's word that the world was created. It is recommended that 2017 Sunday missals and *Living*

with Christ monthly missals be burned and the ashes buried, ideally in a sacred place.







GAUDETE SUNDAY



On this Third Sunday of Advent, signified by the lighting of the rose candle, the Church *rejoices* in the Lord! Gaudete is the Latin word for "Rejoice." Philippians 4:4-5 "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I

will say, Rejoice. Let all men know your forbearance. The Lord is at hand."

The mysterious figure of John the Baptist, introduced in last week's readings, comes into sharper focus today. Who he is, we see in today's Gospel, is best understood by who he isn't. He is not Elijah returned from the heavens, nor the Messiah. He has been anointed by the Spirit since the womb.

John prepares the way for the Lord. His baptism is symbolic, not sacramental. It is a sign given to stir our hearts to repentance. John shows us the One upon whom the Spirit remains, the One who fulfills the promise we hear in today's First Reading. Jesus' bath of rebirth and the Spirit opens a fountain that purifies Israel and gives to all a new heart and a new Spirit.

John comes to us in the Advent readings to show us the light, that we might believe in the One who comes at Christmas. As we sing with Mother Mary in the Responsorial Psalm, the Mighty One has come to lift each of us up, to fill our hunger with bread from heaven. And as Paul exhorts in today's Epistle, we should rejoice, give thanks, and pray without ceasing that God will make us perfectly holy in spirit, soul, and body—that we may be blameless when our Lord comes.
