THE WORD THIS WEEK:

"He was taken up into heaven: there at the right hand of God he took his place."



Ascension in not just a feast that

happens to fall in Eastertide: it is an integral part of the Easter mystery. Remember the Lord's words at the Last Supper: "I am going to prepare a place for, and after I have gone and prepared you a place, I shall return to take you with me." The resurrection presumes the Lord's return to the Father. This is therefore a feast of hope: our hope in the Lord's return, as He went. Our hope that He will take us with Him, when our bodies are raised as His was. Our hope that we will take our place in heaven, where He sits on the Father's right.

On this feast of the Ascension of the Lord, the Church pays attention to communication in our world and encourages us to spread the good news of God's saving grace, revealed in Jesus and made present through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Communicating the good news is a work in progress. There has never been a time in history when people did not need the news of salvation. When much of the communication around us tears down rather than builds up, we have the opportunity to build bridges through our encounters with others.

We are called to be people of hope. Despite all the struggles in our lives and despite all the suffering that we see in our community and the world, we can have hope: hope that the risen Lord will come again to fully restore God's kingdom in the world, as he indeed comes again into our lives through Eucharistic celebrations.

"a voice came out of the cloud, saying, 'This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him!" Finally, the cloud took Jesus out of the sight of the disciples on the day of his ascension and will reveal him as Son of man in glory on the day of his final coming."
