THE WORD THIS WEEK

"He will gather his chosen from the four winds."

In this week's Gospel, Jesus reminds his disciples to learn the lesson of the fig tree, that summer will follow new leaves. He asks us to also be attentive to the ends of things. We begin to contemplate the end of the world - a theme that carries us over next Sunday's feast, Christ the King, and so into Advent. Such a contemplation is not gloomy or morbid: throughout the ages, Christians have been utterly positive about the coming end of all things, because we know what will happen, and in fact we earnestly desire it to come: the phrase that gives this away is in the Gospel: "Then he will send his angels to gather his chosen from the four winds." This gathering of God's children together will be a truly wonderful event, when we will all be completely enfolded in that love of God that we talk so much about.

Nowadays we have been made sensitive to the fact that nature alone is not to blame. We too have our share of responsibility in the dramatic changes in nature and climate. We too are responsible or complicit in the mistrust between religions, races and countries that fuel conflicts.

Jesus promised that when we see darkness and destruction, suffering and pain, "he is near, at the very gates." Both Daniel and Jesus emphasize not the dark side of human history but the bright side of God's saving plan. The end times lie in the hands of God who sends out the Archangel Michael to protect his people when persecuted and, ultimately, Jesus, "the Son of Man coming in clouds' with great power and glory."

The central mystery of our faith is that death is followed by rising. God brings new life from ashes, sends a baby to save the world, dies to death when he walks out of the tomb. No matter how messy life has become, God invites us to be people who pay attention, who wait for and expect new life.

May our hearts turn with gratitude toward God in the midst of struggle, hoping to see what gifts he will brings out of the difficulty.
