The Word This Week

"Whoever remains in me, with me in him, bears fruit in plenty."



In today's gospel, Jesus battles a troubled soul, even raising the possibility of asking the Father to save Him from death on the cross. But Jesus does not give that possibility a real hearing. Instead He quickly concludes

that such an undignified death is the reason for His time on earth. He was sent here to glorify God. This message can help us get passed our inclination to forgo fasting, prayer and charity because there inconvenient, beyond our comfort zone or downright painful.

Jesus talks about the grain of wheat that must die to bear fruit. We grapple with that message every day. Jesus is telling us to die to ourselves, to let go of our lives in this world so that we can live for God. Only then can we keep our lives for eternity.

Today this comes out strongly for all of us, with two of the three readings emphasizing the moral aspects of life in Christ: it is not simply enough to "belong" to him: our belonging must be shown by the works we do, by the fruits we bear - while remembering of course that we cannot bear fruit except in Him.
