The Word This Week

"Whoever remains in me, with me in him, bears fruit in plenty."

Jesus invites us in today's Gospel to abide in Him, just as Christ promises to abide in us. The verb to abide is rare in Scripture and even more so in the New Testament outside John's Gospel and letters, although it occurs notably in 1 Corinthians 13:13: "And now faith, hope and love abide."

Today, however, we hear this verb three times in the Second Reading from John's first letter and twice more in the Gospel from John. The common context for these instances of abide is love. If we love as God loves us, obeying God's commandment to show our faith in Christ by our love for one another and for God. John says we will abide in Christ and Christ in us. Conversely, we are reminded in the Gospel that "apart from" Christ, apart from God's love, we "can do nothing."



Love is at the heart of authentic Christian discipleship. Love is both the precondition for, and the fruit of, the mutual abiding relationship between God and us. By our love and God's love for us, we build one another up as Church and we come

to live more intimately the Easter we celebrate. We come to be more fully the image of God who is love and who abides in us, as we abide in God.

SUPPORT YOUR PARISH

Dear Parishioners,

In order to assist in limiting the spread of the COVID-19 virus and to adhere to the regulations of the Government of Ontario during this state of emergency, all churches in



the Archdiocese of Toronto have limited attendance capacity at this time.

At a time like this it can be uncomfortable to talk about giving. Our primary concern is the health and well-being of our parishioners. However, these difficult circumstances show just how important the offertory is to the life of our parishes. The reality is that our parishes rely on the support of their parishioners to operate — parish salaries, programs and ongoing operating costs (heating, water, electricity, etc.) are funded through the generosity of it parishioners. It will be a challenge for a parish to maintain operations without the usual weekly offertory collection.

If you are unable to attend Mass at this time, there are several ways you can continue to support your parish at this time:

- Drop off or mail your regular weekly offertory contribution to the parish office.
- Contribute through pre-authorized giving if your parish offers it. You can obtain a form from your parish office. Contributions are withdrawn from your bank account on the 20th of each month.
- You can contribute to the offertory via on-line banking. To do this, we need to send you your unique account number. Please e-mail us at campaign@archtoronto.org. In the body of the email provide us with your name, address, parish name and municipality. We will email you your account information which you can use to set up the Archdiocese of Toronto as a payee in your on-line banking. Your gift will be forwarded to your parish. You can make a one time or recurring gift to your offertory.
