## The Word This Week "Little girl, I tell you to get up!"

Today we are invited to marvel at one of the most dramatic and amazing of the Lord's miracles; the raising back to life of the daughter of Jairus. The story is told with a level of emotional realism: the calm faith but dreadful fear of Jairus, the servants who bring the news of his daughter's death, the calm reassurance of Jesus and even the laughter of the servant who mock Jesus, all these make this a story that can engage us and speak to us. And what it says is something profound: all the miracles of the Lord proclaim the Kingdom of God, the world the way God wants it to be. God does not want us to die: death is not part of God's plan for us. This is reinforced by the unfamiliar first reading from the book of Wisdom, which opens our listening to God's Word today with the dramatic phrase, "Death was not God's doing." God created us to live forever and the raising of Jairus' daughter to life is a vivid and outstanding proclamation of this truth. Today's Gospel clearly shows us who Jesus truly is. He is the Son of God. He could sense the "power had gone forth from him" when the hemorrhaging woman touched His garment. Jesus is inviting and challenging us to walk in faith. May we begin to live not according to our limited view but by God's limitless possibilities.

#### **WE ARE OPEN**

We are excited to share that thanks to an amendment to the provincial government's re-opening plan, the Archdiocese of Toronto has returned to in-person Mass. Worship Safe protocols will continue to be in place at this time.

Churches will be able to accommodate up to 15 per cent of the building's capacity, with six-feet of physical distancing between households. In Stage Two, which is expected to commence in July, capacity limits will increase to 25 per cent, with physical distancing.

Livestream Masses will continue to be offered at many parishes for those who cannot physically attend Mass at this time. The dispensation from Sunday Mass continues at this time.
