The Word This Week "He makes the deaf hear and the dumb speak."

What shows us the presence of God? In the Biblical world it was miracles - signs, which pointed towards the emergence of a new



Kingdom, the Kingdom of God. This had been prophesied from of old: it was said that One would come, and also that certain things would be associated with this Messiah which would display the perfection of the Kingdom God wanted to establish. Jesus, in both His preaching and His miracles, proclaims that the Kingdom of God is at hand, in His own person. He fulfils the prophecies of the past, as He displays to the people of His own time, and to us, the nature of Gods Kingdom: in it all diseases and afflictions are abolished: so opening the man's ears and eyes tells us two things: first that Jesus is God, present in our midst, and secondly that He calls us into a Kingdom where all is perfect.

St. James calls each of us to follow in Jesus' footsteps — may we participate in the kingdom by reaching beyond barriers in order to show kindness and love to others. The sign of God's miraculous love is present to us every day through words and deeds that, inspired by grace, bring healing and comfort. These small miracles bring God's light to the places of darkness in our world. If we open our hearts to this visceral love, won't we too want to zealously share the Good News?

We hope you all had a safe and enjoyable summer and are glad to have you back safe and sound.


We also extend a warm welcome to all those who have just moved into the area or are new to our parish family. We certainly hope that you will feel at home with us.

Changes to Livestream Coverage at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica

During the COVID-19 pandemic, the livestream Masses from St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica in Toronto gained a loyal following among Catholics living all around the world. We were happy to be there for the faithful during the worst days of the lockdowns. However, as Canada continues its gradual return to normal life, the cathedral is starting to transition back to its prepandemic routines. As such, starting on Monday, August 30, weekday Mass livestreams from the cathedral will move from 7:30 a.m. to 12:10 p.m. Sunday Masses from the cathedral will continue to be livestreamed at noon. Cardinal Thomas Collins, Archbishop of Toronto, will regularly celebrate livestreamed Sunday Masses starting on August 30.
