# "You cannot be the slave both of God and money."

How easy to take the words of Jesus out of context: "Use money to win you friends", is one of those lines that sounds strange to us outside the context of the parable and the teaching in today's Gospel. Even the parable itself can seem a little strange; is Jesus really recommending that we act like dishonest stewards? No, of course not! The point that reveals this is hidden half way down: "The children of this world are more shrewd in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light." Jesus in a way praises the effort of the dishonest steward, but wishes that it was directed less to worldly things, but to the things of heaven. Can we be as resourceful and clear-headed with the practice of our Christian faith? Jesus' kingdom teaching demands decisive action. Given that it is possible to serve only one master with utter devotion, in what or whom will we place our trust? The Christian is meant to choose God above all else, loving God alone with unswerving devotion. Once such a choice is made, it is revealed even in the smallest actions, a consistent ethic of life.

We can take from today's readings some ideas about plans for action: give freely to others, rather than enslaving or destroying them; demonstrate a sincere and active concern for the salvation of all, even those who can harm us; be ready to sacrifice ourselves for others for the sake of the kingdom. Why? Because this is what God is like, revealed to us in Jesus the Christ. Blessed be the name of the Lord!


