THE WORD THIS WEEK "I do not tell you to forgive seven times, but seventy-seven times."

Jesus tells a dramatic story in the Gospel, to make a very important point: the desperate need in our world for forgiveness and reconciliation. How many chances do we give each other? As many as seven? How often do we shut doors on people, even family and friends, saying "That's it; you've just gone too far this time: never again? When Jesus says that we must forgive "seventy-seven" times, he implies that we never stop forgiving, whatever happens. He doesn't just say this, however: even when they do the worst thing that could be done to him, nailing him to a cross, Jesus puts these words into practice: "Father, forgive them..." As his disciples, we must do likewise.

We had better stop and think for a moment today and reflect that we ourselves may be that merciless servant described in the parable. Every time we have sinned mortally, we have incurred an unpayable debt to God. Each time we have received absolution we have come out of God's courtroom as free men. A weight greater than a large debt has been lifted from our shoulders. A worse than generations of earthly fate imprisonment — that is, eternal slavery — has been spared us because of God's loving, infinite mercy. How then can it happen that we could be so heartless, mean, and foolish as to refuse to forgive a neighbor for some offense he has committed against us?

God calls us to himself through many situations. Our struggle to forgive is in our human nature. Surrender leads us to the abundant transforming grace that he offers us through the Holy Spirit. We receive this powerful gift in the Eucharist, his body and blood.
