THE WORD THIS WEEK "Many are called, but few are chosen."

Do you rejoice in the coming banquet that is heaven? Are you clothing your heart in a way that is pleasing to God? The parable in today's Gospel appears to offer a grim picture of our final salvation – that God calls everyone, but that only a few are chosen. It isn't, however, all doom and gloom. Our presence here expresses our willingness to put on the robe of Christ so that we may stand confidently and joyfully in the light of God's friendship. We have been called with the many.
