THE WORD THIS WEEK "Give ... to God the things that are God's."

What is our heart's loyalty? In today's Gospel, the Pharisees attempt to trap Jesus by asking about the obligation of paying taxes to the emperor. They know that if Jesus says that taxes should be paid, he would show a loyalty to another authority over their religious authority. But Jesus does not answer as they expect. "Give ... to God the things that are Jesus' answer helps us reflect on God's." loyalties in a new light. What are the things that are God's? Everyone on this earth belongs to God. All are made in his image. Therefore, it is right that all men and women, 'from the rising to the setting of the sun', should know the God to whom they belong. The only desire of our God is that all should know and love him, and find in him the fulfilment that they seek. We put obstacles in our spiritual path whenever we set anything above seeking God in the heart of the Gospel and placing God first in our hearts. So how do we clear away the obstacles from our path? We acknowledge that the "things that are God's" are all things. We owe God our very hearts, first and foremost, uncluttered by other attachments. When something else comes first before God, we have placed ourselves as the first priority. Seeking to discover how our priorities are not first rooted in trust and gratitude for God helps to loosen their hold on us.
