## The Word This Week

# "He took her by the hand and said to her ... 'Little girl, get up!'"

In today's Gospel, Jesus says, "Do not fear, only believe." He is challenging us to walk by faith, not by sight, even when we do not understand. Jesus is calling us to believe him when we are searching for and trying to find answers to our questions. We have all experienced doubt, as Thomas did, many times. We must realize that believing Jesus is not just hearing his words but absorbing and living them. Our faith develops and grows as we gain insight from the words and example of Jesus. We begin to understand what's behind and beyond the words he proclaims. realize there is much more than meets the eye in what Jesus is saying.

The Gospels give us only some of the many miracles our Lord worked. They give them to prove that he was what he claimed to be — the Son of God and the long-expected Savior; and also, to prove his compassionate understanding and sympathy for suffering humanity.

Today, let us say a fervent prayer of thanksgiving to God for the gift of active faith which he has given us and beg of him to keep that faith ever alive in our hearts. We should be inspired by Jairus' faith, who believed Jesus could heal his daughter. If we are candid with our Lord about what is going on in our hearts and ask him to ease our fears, hurts, burdens, poverty and inadequacy, he will heal us and bless others through us.

Let us pray that God in his divine love will increase our faith in him and give us the grace to persevere in loving him and serving others for his sake.
