

THE WORD THIS WEEK

"There is nothing outside a person that by going in can defile them."

In today's Gospel, Jesus is encouraging us to listen and understand that the deepest desires of our hearts are reflected in our everyday actions, words and decisions. He is stirring our hearts and inviting us to reflect on the source of our spiritual well-being.

Jesus understands we struggle in our human weakness. We live in a secular world that measures our worth by what we accomplish and possess. This focus, even when it is not what we want, leads us away from God who deeply loves us, to the point of giving us his very self. The gospel also offers us an opportunity to understand the role of the Pharisees in Judaism and why Jesus and others had such strong feelings against their behaviour. Jesus tells them that they are hypocrites: "they honour God with their lips but their heart is far from God"; they obey the law and the traditions, not to please God, but to be seen and admired by men; their motive, self-glorification, vitiates every otherwise good act they perform.

Jesus shows that only those who are sinners in need of a healer – who do not have righteousness in themselves, who are devoid of divine entitlement, who do not deserve to be in fellowship with God – are the ones he came to call to repentance. True Christians are those who boast in Christ alone as their only hope, knowing it is the work of Christ by the grace of God that guarantees salvation.
