

THE WORD THIS WEEK

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only-begotten Son." That profound sentence of unconditional love is foundational to our faith. God's love is not limited by ethnicity, geography, ethnicity, background or merit; it is all-encompassing, for all of creation.

This is the salvation and redemptive power of Christ's sacrifice. The analogy of Moses lifting up the serpent in the wilderness is a metaphorical bridge to the crucifixion of Jesus. Just as the Israelites were healed by looking at the raised bronzed serpent, we too are healed by believing in the redemption brought by Jesus when he is lifted up on the Cross.

God's love, personified by Jesus' willing sacrifice for the salvation of all, requires us to look deeply to extend that same love and mercy to ourselves, no matter our sins, and to others. His mission was not to condemn the world but

to save it. Our current world is often quick to judgement and condemnation. The gospel calls to us through the centuries offering a different perspective, a longer view to our life. The path to salvation, the sense of completeness



and peace offered by the way of the Cross, requires us to emulate love and mercy to all, extending the same compassion and forgiveness we have received.

O God, who willed that your Only Begotten Son should undergo the Cross to save the human race, grant, we pray, that we, who have known his mystery on earth, may merit the grace of his redemption in heaven.
